### Professional Outreach Program Fellowship Grant Application

**The purpose of this grant program is to encourage projects in creative growth, research, or to provide inspiration for new directions and explorations in turned wood art.**

Please submit the following;

**A Grant Proposal Description** of your intent for funds, including a brief budget of how the money will be spent. This can include travel expenses, materials, research, etc. Grant amounts will be based on merit of the proposal with a typical maximum grant at approximately but not limited to \$5000 dollars US. There is no minimum amount which can be requested. This description should not exceed two typed pages. For further guidance refer to the grant page on the AAW website or contact a POP committee member for more clarification.

**Resume** or CV and Bio. not to exceed three pages. Please include, if any, exhibits, permanent and public collections and publications that you may have been a part of in the past.

**Up to Twenty Digital Images** will be reviewed from each applicant. You may submit a maximum of twenty and a minimum of ten files which can include detail views. These images can be of current work, past work, objects of inspiration that you intend to translate into new work for the grant period, or both. The image should be representative of your proposal's intent. Image files should be on a single CD or DVD with file names which should include your last name and a corresponding number to a description page if wish to include one. Descriptions are not required, but in some cases may be helpful in conveying your intent. Slides will not be accepted. All images should be saved as JPG files no larger than 3 MB each.

**Support Materials** may be submitted to assist your proposal in hard-copy, pdf or Word file formats, and are recommended but are not required. Examples of these materials are exhibition announcements, reviews or articles written by others about your work, etc.
