Our tour will access the downtown area, the “Railroad Era” of the Alvarado Hotel, an original “Harvey House”.

The National Hispano Cultural Center features exhibits and artworks for the past 300 years in a unique architectural setting.

We will tour the University of New Mexico campus, the Bart Prince home, and our arts and crafts area known as “Nob Hill”.

The Albuquerque Balloon Park hosts the United State’s first world-class Balloon Museum, and the 72-acre field which hosts the Albuquerque International Balloon Fiesta in October.

The North Valley Rio Grande Blvd. area features rural, rustic homes in a beautiful bosque setting. Arabian, Andalusian and Lipizzan horses are bred in this area.

Tour of the Albuquerque Old Town area, including an overview of the Albuquerque Museum, the Museum of Natural History, the Explora Science Center, and the Rio Grande Botanic Gardens and Aquarium.
