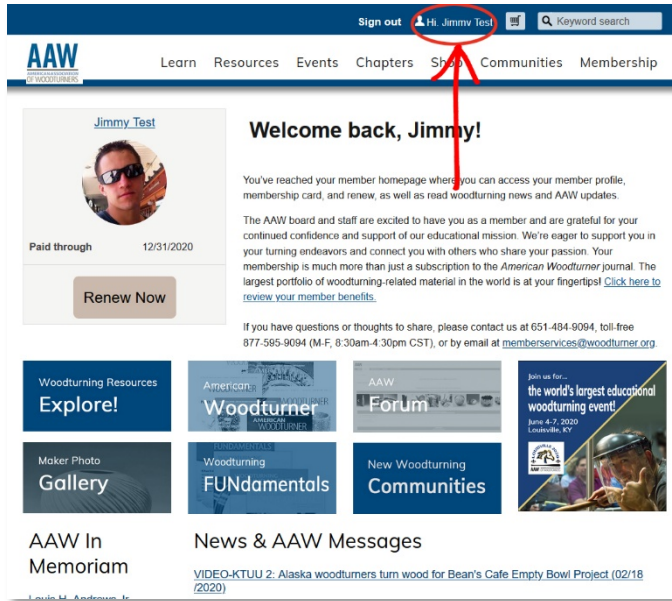

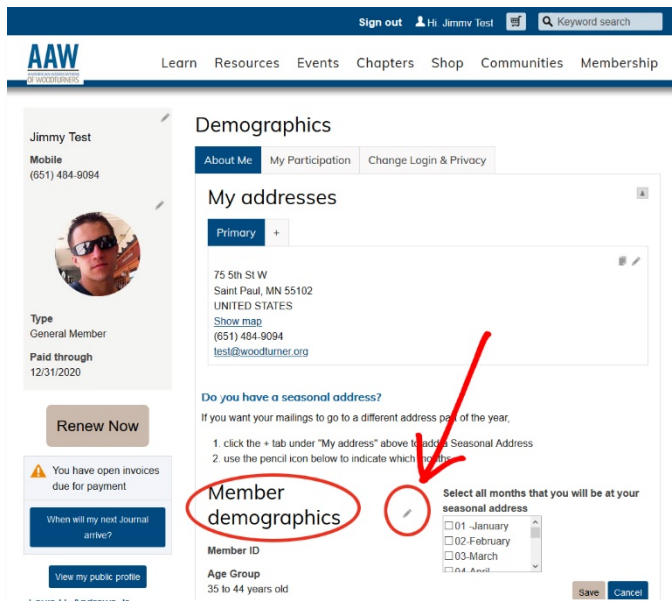
Sign in to the AAW website at woodturner.org.

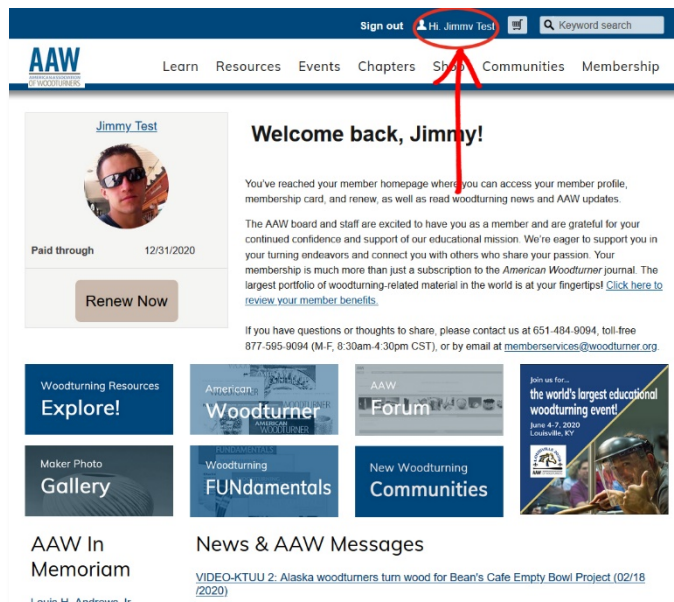

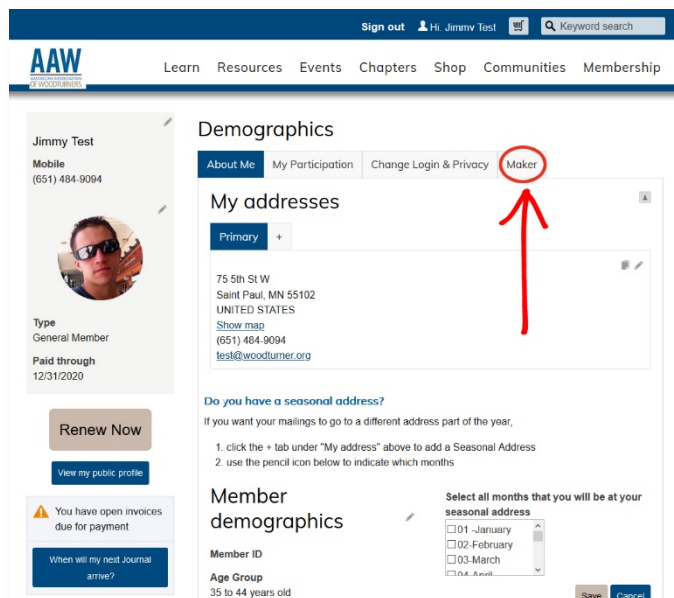

- Allowed file types are jpg and png only. (Not included are jpeg, tif, eps, pdf, psd, etc.)
- To avoid distortion, photos dimensions must be 500px x 500px.
- Photo file size should be less than 100KB. Please do not upload high-resolution images because they slow the gallery’s ability to search and display images.

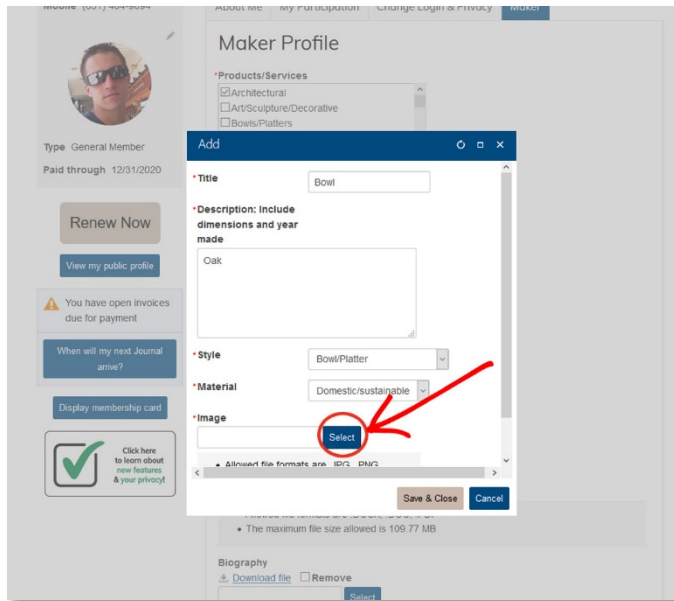

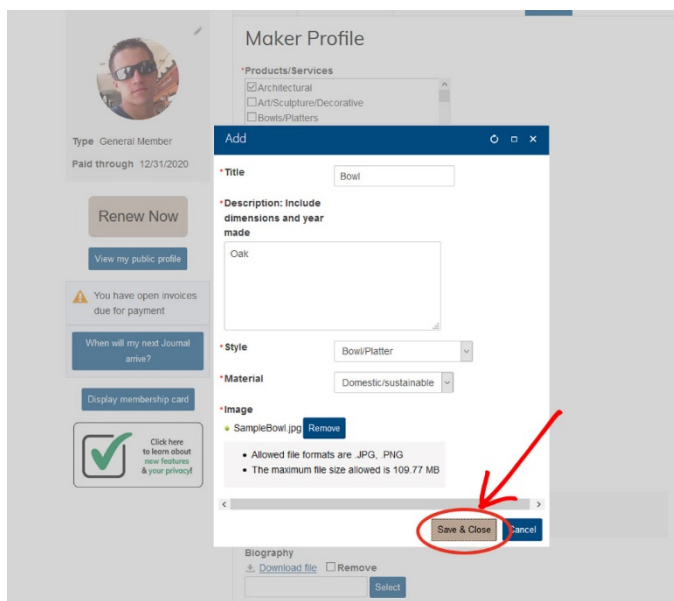

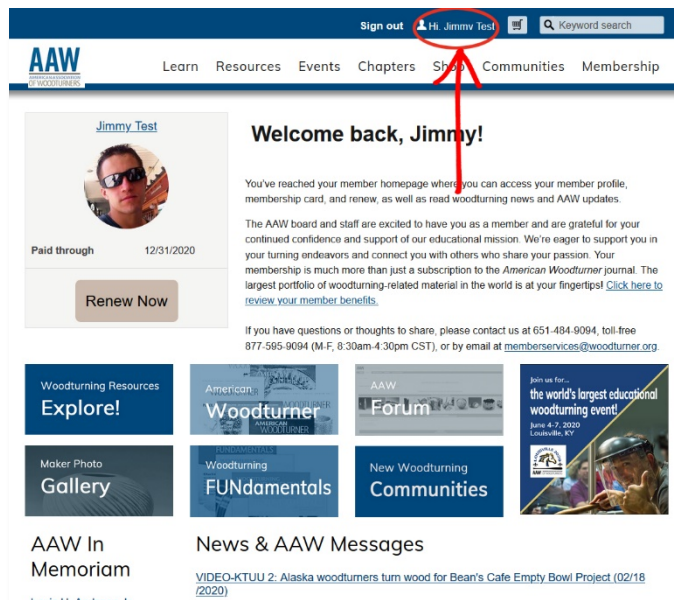
To upload an image, under “Image,” click “Select,” which will enable you to browse your computer for photos of your work. When you locate the photo to be uploaded on your computer, click the photo, then click the “Open” button.



Next, click the “Save & Close” button to save the image to your maker gallery. (Tip: To avoid distortion, upload **square** images for best results. The recommended size for images is 500 pixels x 500 pixels.)



Refresh your browser and click your name in the blue section at the top of your screen again to be able to view your newly uploaded photos on your Maker Profile.
